INTRODUCTION

The Hong Kong Medical Society of the United Kingdom (HKMSUK) is a non-profit organisation founded in 2016. We represent the interests of the medical students and doctors in the United Kingdom who have previously lived in Hong Kong or are intending to work in Hong Kong.

SOCIETY MEMBERS

As of June 2020, the society has established an extensive network of over **400 members** from 34 of the 38 medical schools in the United Kingdom. Our events are hosted across the country - depending on the scale,

We are always looking to recruit new members and develop our community; in light of our rate of growth over the past 4 years and our aggressive expansion policies through multiple collaborations with other established societies and emphasis on our social media platforms, we expect the society to continue its growth substantially over the coming years.

In addition, the society has created the position of **Alumni Officer** this academic year to direct our newly formed **Alumni Branch**, in recognition of growing interest from HKMSUK alumni and current Hong Kong affiliated doctors to meet and connect with their peers. The role will be held by a doctor in the United Kingdom, who will oversee the formation of a community of Hong Kong doctors for networking and socialising. 

Changes to Society & Partnerships

With the ever increasing number of participants in our nationwide society, our workload has warranted reorganisation of our committee structure. To manage our growing society, we have introduced the new roles of Internal and External Vice Presidents in place of a sole Vice President. The rationale behind this decision is to ensure even division of responsibilities and maintain standards in our ventures in face of expansion. Furthermore, we have altered the advisory board from all committee members of the previous year to the previous 3 terms of presidents. Since the purpose of the advisory board is to provide their perspective concerning the direction and operation of the society, the new structure encourages more use of the board.

Our Goals for 2020-2021

This year, we aim to tackle social distancing by moving the majority of our planned events to various online platforms. Despite ongoing issues, we will continue to carry out our 2020 events to the best of our abilities, such as "Aspiring Medics" and our upcoming collaboration with the Hong Kong Medical Society of Australia (HKMSA).

- Move majority of events to online platforms until social distancing guidance is updated.
- Carry on with 2020 events HKMSA Collaboration, Doctors Speciality Talk.
- Increase membership count and expand to more medical schools.
- Establish membership retainment schemes.
- Introduce new sponsorship features for sponsors as an adjustment due to COVID-19.

COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

Our committee consists of 9 members.

The **President** oversees HKMSUK and makes major decisions affecting the direction of the society, serving a crucial role in maintaining the day to day operation of the committee.

The **External Vice President** helps manage treasurer and secretary related tasks, keep the society organised and reach out to new members.

The **Internal Vice President** assists the events and liaison officers in planning and preserving relationships with other organisations.

Our **Treasurer** is responsible for discussion and liaising with external partnerships, working closely to supervise sponsorship matters.

Our **Events Officer** brainstorms and oversees execution of events across the year, recording and improving the satisfaction of attendees for future events.

The **Liaison Officer** serves as the intermediary between the committee and the society, managing our University Ambassadors (pg.9) and ensuring clear communication between our board and our members.

The **Publicity Officer** ensures all design and public promotional material are of exceptional quality, keeping a simultaneous eye on our social media presence as a society.

Our **Secretary** maintains clarity within our nationwide society, remaining informed on all ongoing activities in order to assist various ongoing projects.

Lastly, our society is advised by a **Doctor's Representative**, helping connect graduates with our society and advise development of post graduate events.

NEW FORTHCOMING EVENTS

1) HKMSUK X HKMSA X ISN: Practicing Around the Globe

Our first collaboration with the Hong Kong Medical Society of Australia and the International Student's Network of the Australia Medical Student's Association. The webinar will explore the processes of application to work in Australia, Canada, the United Kingdom and Singapore as an International Medical Graduate. Invited speakers are current medical students and doctors from the aforementioned societies.

2) Comparing Specialities Event

The event is an online webinar led by doctors working in the United Kingdom and Hong Kong that will contrast the training pathways and training experiences in Hong Kong and the UK. It aims to shed light on differences and similarities between potential pathways medical students can choose upon graduation.

3) COVID Socials

A series of online events curated by our Events Officer for our members to participate in and enjoy during quarantine. An example would be our inaugural Quiz Night, where randomised teams must battle it out through multiple question rounds on Zoom to be crowned HKMSUK Champions!

RECURRING EVENTS

1) Aspiring Medics (100 participants)

Each year, Medical Students speak to HK high school students about their experience in applying to medical school in the UK.



An option every HK medical student studying in the UK considers is returning to work in HK. We regularly plan talks with doctors providing insight into their HKMLE experience.

3) Meet & Greet (130 participants)

As new members join our society every year, we plan introductory social events such as the meet and greet for new freshers and members to meet with each other and existing members. Last year, 8 gatherings took place across the UK, with participants from 16+ universities.

4) HikeMSUK (20 participants)

Our annual hiking trips vary on the time of year, sometimes in the UK and others in Hong Kong.

5) Chinese New Year Gathering (30 participants)

Another chance to network and meet new people, the CNY event celebrates festivities as a society.

6) Christmas Gathering (30 participants)

Similar to the CNY, a social is planned in December involving dinner and socialising. HKMSUK's celebration of festivities took place in the City of London last year!

ONGOING PROGRAMMES

UNIVERSITY AMBASSADORS SCHEME

The University Ambassadors scheme is a programme that we've run since our inception in 2016. The programme plays an integral role in the day-to-day operations of the society by acting as a local conduit for promotion and engagement. Every year, we host an application cycle for interested members to apply to become a University Ambassador for our organisation at their university. Application is generally competitive, so we have a rigorous, well-established system to appoint candidates that we believe are passionate about the society and would excel in the role. Primarily, University Ambassadors are expected to carry out these following duties:

- Recruit new members for HKMSUK.
- Act as point of contact and representative of the society.
- Assist in organising local gatherings and events.
- Contribute to a Fresher's Guide for their university.
- Disseminate information and provide assistance in organising elective opportunities in Hong Kong.

The responsibilities that have been italicised are new responsibilities that we have added this year to reflect the ambitions of our society and to better serve our members

So far, the scheme has been a great success. Over the span of 4 years, our society has grown from being very much a London-based organisation to an organisation with University Ambassadors in **20 medical schools** and members from **34 medical schools** in the United Kingdom that are actively engaged in society events both in the United Kingdom and in Hong Kong. We are extremely proud of the scheme, because it has enabled us to expand at an incredible rate whilst forming close relationships with our member base. We envision the scheme to continue contributing to the growth of our society, especially with the establishment of 5 new medical schools in the country.

ONGOING PROGRAMMES

ALUMNI PROGRAMME

To realise our dream to act as an overarching organisation that represents the interests of medical students and doctors with affiliations to Hong Kong, we have created an **Alumni Branch** this academic year to run alongside our **Student Branch**. This is in response to working doctors from Hong Kong who have expressed interest in creating a platform to network and socialise with their peers. Our vision for the branch is to nurture a community of Hong Kong affiliated doctors to remain connected after graduation, foster lifelong friendships and form supportive networks.

Our society recognises this is an ambitious venture, so we are taking baby steps to ensure viability and quality. Over the course of 2020-2021, the society will:

- Spread word of this exciting new initiative by contacting existing members who have graduated, word of mouth and advertising through social media.
- Create a closed Facebook group for members to facilitate networking and discussion as well as be updated on society news and events.
- Host events in London and Birmingham (3 deaneries each) in consideration of the locations of our member base, with the view of expanding to other cities in the following years.

Initially, we expect the makeup of the Alumni Branch to primarily be composed of junior doctors due to the society's current audience and reach. While this is the case, we are confident that the member base will eventually include doctors from every stage of training.

PAST ACHIEVEMENTS



AT THE CROSSROADS CONFERENCE (LONDON, 2019)

On November 9th, HKMSUK held our first ever medical conference, in conjunction with SMSUK (Singaporean Medical Society of UK) and MMI (Malaysian medics international). The day included lectures, a panel of speakers for a Q&A, a poster presentation and held several workshops that included topics on: Suturing, O+G, CMT/CST talks, Nephrology, CV building, AFP, A+E, Breast Surgery and Paediatrics.



HOMECOMING: WORKING AND TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES IN HK (HONG KONG, 2019)

HKMSUK welcomed a panel of foreign-trained doctors working under the limited registration scheme to speak about their careers under the scheme. Dr. Sharon Wong detailed the Hospital Authority's scheme while Dr. Michael Wong, Dr. Anthony Chan, Dr. Howard Chan, and Dr. Kelvin Choi spoke about post-medical school and living as specialists under this scheme. Furthermore, they spoke about their experiences with the HKMLE (Hong Kong Medical Licentiate Exam).

THE FUTURE OF HEALTHCARE SYSTEM IN HK (HONG KONG, 2018)

Over 90 medical students and doctors attended a talk given by Professor Sophia Chan, the Secretary of Food and Health of Hong Kong. It was followed by a presentation by Dr Sharon Wong and Dr Edmund Fung from the HA and DH respectively. They both explored pathways through which foreign trained doctors may return to work in the HK health system.



HOSPITAL AUTHORITY & HKETO CAREERS AND RECRUITMENT TALK (LONDON 2018)

The Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office (HKETO) held their talk "Opportunities for Overseas Doctors in Hong Kong" featuring speakers Mr Matthew Cheung Kin-Chung, Chief Secretary for Administration, Dr Sharon Wong, from the Department of Health, and Professor Leong, Chairman of the Hospital Authority.





ELECTIVES IN HONG KONG (LONDON 2018)

At the Institute of Education, Dr Jeremy Chan and Dr Lawrence Nip spoke about their experience of undertaking medical electives in Hong Kong. Dr. Chan also gave a brief presentation on audits and quality improvement projects, highlighting their importance in applications for specialty training posts in the UK. The event finished with a social dinner.

DOCTORS ACROSS BORDERS (HONG KONG 2017)

In August, we were fortunate enough to have Dr. Andrew Kuk, Dr. Kenneth Wong and Dr. Nicole Tsim from Doctors Across Borders to share their experiences of working in Hong Kong, in the UK and other countries. We ended the event with a social dinner.





CALL ME DR. - HOW TO PREPARE FOR FY TRAINING (LONDON 2017)

"Call Me Doctor - How to Prepare for Foundation Year Training", saw three inspiring speakers, Dr. Clara Lai, Dr. Katherine Law, and Dr. Ernest Lim, who each shared their unique experiences of the Foundation programme after medical school.

On 19th November, we held our first talk from an external speaker, Dr. Gary Lau, sharing his clinical and research experiences both in Hong Kong and UK as well as providing useful advice on how to maximise our career opportunities.


